Evaluation:

Students' performance will be evaluated on the basis of participation, preparation and three mid-term tests. Each mid-term test is 33 (test 1), 33 (test 2) and 34 (test 3) per cent of the final mark. PLEASE NOTE: 15% of each test is based on the relevant self-study sections. (NOTE: Ask your teacher about **Test 0**.) The student can re-sit each test once. The student decides on the date of the re-sit, which has to be approved by the course instructor. Full attendance adds 5 points to the final score. On meetings no. 2, 4 and 6 there are short revision tests which can add up to 4 points.
